

# Inflammation Test

Simple Blood Draw • Non-Invasive • No Fasting Required • Quantitative

**Why measure inflammation?**

1. Inflammation is both an initiator and propagator of many diseases.
2. The inflammatory response rises fast with disease/ falls fast upon resolution.
3. Measuring inflammation is more sensitive than routine chemistries.

**Why this test?**

**Use this test for overall health status and monitoring therapy.**



## Monitor Therapy

It doesn't get much easier. Use CRP/HPT to determine if **treatment is effective** for:

- Infections
- IMHA/ITP
- Inflammatory Bowel Disease
- Immune-mediated polyarthropathy

## Wellness Screening

Use CRP and Haptoglobin to confirm health and help identify reversible conditions.

**What does your pet's results tell you?**

<b>Normal</b>	<b>Low risk of systemic disease</b>	<b>Recheck at next annual visit</b>
<b>Low</b>	<b>Early Stage Disease- Reversible</b>	<b>Resolve Chronic Inflammation</b>
<b>High</b>	<b>Disease Present</b>	<b>Identify and resolve disease</b>
